PROTECT YOURSELF!

The aim of this lesson is to give you the chance to make a brief PRESENTATION on what you have learned during the Safe Technology programme. This is how: Working as a member of a group of four or five students make a list of the important things that have been discussed during the programme.

List anything that concerns safe use of the internet in this column

List anything that concerns the law in Seychelles in this column

List anything that concerns working in the Seychelles in this column

List anything that concerns school in this column

Now, with the help of your teacher your group will make a large, poster-sized SPIDERCHART which will include all of the topics in your table. Use different colours to identify which topics come under which heading. Some topics might fall in more than one heading. You can illustrate your chart with drawings.

Now your group can PRESENT the information that you have put together to the class. Decide who in your group is going to talk about what and, if you have time, rehearse what you are going to do or say. You can use the spiderchart as a REFERENCE but can also use drama, music, pictures to make your presentation more interesting.

Speaking in front of an audience can be scary, but if you prepare your presentation well you will be able to COMMUNICATE your ideas clearly to your class. At the end of the presentations you can make a school display of the charts you have made, using materials from all of the Safe Technology lessons. When you have completed this you will have finished the Safe Technology programme. Well done!
